Our show season runs 01 August to 31st July each year. The WAQHA endeavours to bring to you, our members, the best and most versatile range of competition, clinics and practice shows we can. We aim to encourage members at every level from Improvers to Select Amateurs.

To be in the running to receive a WAQHA End of Year High Point Award, you must be a current financial member of the WAQHA and compete at a minimum of two WAQHA APPROVED shows.

WAQHA, PRAC & WAPHA show points are automatically included in the WAQHA End of Year High Point Awards. WAQHA have also included awards to recognise Quarter Horses that are showcasing our breed in disciplines outside the Western Show Arena. Check out the qualifying criteria for more information.

*The WAQHA committee has the discretion to change or alter awards or eligibility criteria throughout the season. As our association continues to grow, we will review the awards offered.

AQHA approved show points are submitted to the AQHA by the WAQHA points collator on your behalf.

NOTES FOR MEMBERS:

- Regardless of the number of horses entered, points are tallied as:
- ♣ AQHA Approved Shows:

(not including Futurity/Feature Events)

- 1st place = 3 points
- 2nd place = 2 point
- 3rd place = 1 point
- ♥ Non AQHA Approved Shows (B shows):
- [†] 1st place = 2 point
 - 2nd place = 1 point
- Triple points are awarded for members competing at the QH State Championships held in WA, if ran by the WAQHA.
- Double points awarded for AA shows.
- ☆ Champion/Reserve Halter
- If 3 horses − 2 points Champion 1 x Reserve
- If 2 horses − 1 point − Champion 0.5 Point − Reserve
- ♣ No points awarded for 1 horse contesting for Champ.
- If a tiebreaker is required, it will go on the number of first places, then second if that can't be determined.
- Awards will be presented to the winner only.

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

OVERALL HIGH POINT AWARDS

Novice Amateur

Qualifying events for this overall award will be Showmanship, Hunt Seat Equitation, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, Western Horsemanship & Western Pleasure. Winner must be competing on an AQHA registered horse and have competed at minimum 2 x approved WAQHA shows throughout each season.

Amateur

Qualifying events for this overall award will be: Showmanship, Hunt Seat Equitation, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, Western Horsemanship, Ranch Riding, Reining & Western Pleasure. Winner must be competing on an AQHA registered horse and have competed at 2 x WAQHA approved shows throughout each season.

Junior Youth

Qualifying events for this overall award will be Showmanship, Hunt Seat Equitation, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, Western Horsemanship, Ranch Riding, Reining & Western Pleasure. Winner must be competing on an AQHA registered horse and have competed at 2 x WAQHA approved shows throughout each season.

Senior Youth

Qualifying events for this overall award will be Showmanship, Hunter Under Saddle, HSE, Trail & Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, Ranch riding, Reining. Winner must be competing on an AQHA registered horse and have competed at 2x WAQHA approved shows throughout each season.

Novice Youth

Qualifying events for this overall award will be Showmanship, Hunt Seat Equitation, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, Western Horsemanship & Western Pleasure. Winner must be competing on an AQHA registered horse and have competed at 2 x WAQHA approved shows throughout each season.

Select Amateur

Qualifying events for this overall award will be Showmanship, Hunt Seat Equitation, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, Western Horsemanship, Reining, Ranch Riding & Western Pleasure. Winner must be competing on an AQHA registered horse and have competed at 2 x approved WAQHA shows throughout each season.

Yearling

Qualifying events for this overall award will be Led Trail, Lungeline and Hunter in Hand. Winner must be competing on An AQHA registered horse and have competed at 2 x WAQHA approved show throughout each season.

Two Year Old

Qualifying events for this overall award will be Led Trail, Lungeline and Hunter in Hand. Winner must be competing on a AQHA registered horse and have competed at 2 x WAQHA approved show throughout each season.

Junior Horse

Qualifying events for this overall award will be Hunter in Hand, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, Reining, Ranch Riding & Western Pleasure. Winner must be competing on an AQHA registered horse and have competed at 2 x WAQHA shows throughout each season.

Senior Horse

Qualifying events for this overall award will be Hunter in Hand, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, Reining, Ranch Riding & Western Pleasure. Winner must be competing on an AQHA registered horse and have competed at 2 x WAQHA approved show throughout each season.

Halter Horse

Qualifying events for this overall award will be Halter including Champion/Reserve placings. Winner must be competing with an AQHA registered horse and have competed at 2 x WAQHA approved show throughout each season.

All Age Cow Horse

The purpose of this award is to recognise our breed competing in different disciplines. The High Point Cow Horse will include Camp drafting, Cutting, Working Cow Horse, Roping and Barrells Results will be taken from All Age Horse events offered on programs accepted by WAQHA. Horse must

All Age Western Dressage Horse

Whilst the WAQHA do not offer Western Dressage classes at their shows, the purpose of this award is to recognise our breed competing in different disciplines. This high point award will include all Western Dressage tests offered (Walk/Jog & Walk/Jog/Lope) offered on programs accepted by WAQHA. must be a WDA-AUS member and must be competing on an AQHA registered horse that is also licenced with WDA-AUS. They must have competed at 2 x approved events throughout each season. Points will only be awarded for Western Dressage classes that are Affiliated or approved with Western Dressage Australia.

All Age Reining AQHA

The purpose of this award is to recognise our breed competing in different disciplines. The High Point Reining Horse will include AQHA Reining Horse events. Results will be taken from All Age Horse events offered on programs accepted by WAQHA. Winner must be competing on an AQHA registered horse.

All Age Open Ranch Horse The purpose of this award is to recognise our breed competing in different disciplines. The High Point All Age Ranch Horse will include all the Ranch events recognised by the AQHA. Results will be taken from All Age Horse events offered on programs accepted by WAQHA. Winner must be competing on n AQHA registered horse and have competed at 2 x WAQHA show throughout each season.
